The Ledge Game Room Policies

Ages: Must be at least 12 years old to use the Game Room without a parent/guardian present. Children 7-11 must have a family member (ie sibling or parent) 15 or older supervising them.

Clothing: Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Students must dress modestly.

Snacks & Drinks: Snacks & Drinks are permitted in the Game Room in designated areas only. Designated areas include the counter and table. No food or drink near the gaming systems or on the floor. No gum is allowed.

Vandalism: Any student vandalizing the facility in any manner (kicking, hitting, writing, etc.) will be removed immediately. Students may also be held financially responsible for any damages.

Abusive Behavior: Students exhibiting abusive behavior, either verbally or physically, toward a fellow student or employee will be asked to leave the facility immediately. Vulgar Language will not be tolerated. There will be no horseplay in the Game Room.

Discipline Policy: The Game Room operates with a one and done policy. One warning will be given (if not too serious) and then if a second is issued they are asked to leave for the remainder of the day. Three one and done's in a month results in a one month suspension.

Equipment Use: Students will have the opportunity to use various remotes in the game room. To use a remote that is not attached to the game system (Wii remote), students will notify staff who will record their name. When he/she is finished with the remote, they must notify the staff. Do NOT just hand the remote to someone else. Until you have checked it back in, you are responsible for it.

Students returning broken equipment will be charged for the replacement of the equipment and will not be allowed to use the Game Room until the charges are paid in full.

Personal Belongings: Roller blades, bikes, skateboards, and scooters are NOT allowed in the Kroc Center for any amount of time.

All personal belongings including coats, backpacks, gym bags, etc. must be stored in the designated space. The Salvation Army Kroc Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Check in/out: Students will be checked in to a secure database called KidConnect®. We will enter the information given to us on the registration form and you will receive an email with instructions on how to manage/update information on this system should you choose.
